

Bocce Golf Rules

- **Each team consists of 2-4 members, 1-2 on each end of the court.**
- **Flip a coin to see who rolls the palina first and gets their choice of ball color.**
- **Palinas not resting between the centerline and far foul line and not 6 inches from any board will be spotted.**
- **The palina roller putts the first ball trying to get close to the palina.**
- **The opposite team then takes their putt trying to get closer to the palina.**
- **Play continues like regular Bocce, where the team that is farthest from the palina continues to putt until they become closer or have putted their 4 golf balls alternating putts between the two players of the team on that end of the court.**
- **Scoring is also the same. The team with the closest ball gets one point for that ball. If all of the balls of that team are closer than the other team's balls to the palina, the scoring team can gain up to four points.**
- **The team winning the points from the previous frame will roll the palina first.**
- **Play continues until a team has reached 11 points. No shutouts.**
